CCVS 2021 COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

To continue to protect the health and safety of the CCVS community from the spread of COVID-19, the Canadian Centre for Verbatim Studies (CCVS) is implementing a vaccination policy in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. It is only mandatory to validate a student's vaccination status if they are attending in-person, but it is not mandatory to validate a student's vaccination status if they are attending entirely online. This policy will continue to be adapted based on public health recommendations.

CCVS requires all those attending campus in-person to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. This applies to students, employees, clients, contractors, visitors or other attendees. Proof of vaccination will be required upon attendance through an official dose administration receipt (for example, a photograph of a paper vaccination receipt or electronic receipt through email).

You are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving your completed dose of a Health Canada or World Health Organization approved vaccine. If you have been vaccinated with a vaccine other than the approved Health Canada vaccines, individuals will be considered partially vaccinated 14 days after receiving the first dose of a Health Canada approved vaccine. Partially vaccinated individuals will be granted access to the premises for a grace period prior to receiving the second dose of the vaccine, which must be received by no later than November 1, 2021. Until full vaccination status is met, individuals may need to adhere to additional health and safety measures.

Under the Ontario Human Rights Code, students may be exempt from the COVID-19 vaccine under medical or religious exemptions. Those seeking an exemption should email Zoe Horvath at zoe@arbitrationplace.com. Requests will be considered on an individual basis and CCVS reserves the right to make appropriate inquiries to verify the authenticity of the claim. Individuals who are exempt from the vaccine must submit to a COVID-19 test every 7 days and must prove they are COVID-19 negative each time they return to campus.

Attendees attending CCVS in-person who have not received at least one vaccine dose or who have not been granted an exemption under the Ontario Human Rights Code will not be allowed on the CCVS premises.

For the Fall 2021 Term, CCVS premises will not be open to visitors except for a limited list of approved individuals.
